Air Mauritius leases out an Airbus A340-300 to AirAsia X



Air Mauritius will wet lease (aircraft and crew) one of its five Airbus A340-300 - 3B-NAU – Pink Pigeon to AirAsia X for a period of three weeks as from 13th March 09 up to 02nd April 09 with possibility of extension.

The aircraft is planned to operate on the Kuala Lumpur-Perth route.
