### **Air Mauritius moves to Terminal 2 at Frankfurt Airport**

#### **More convenience for passengers**

Air Mauritius will shift its operations from Terminal 1 to Terminal 2 at Frankfurt Airport effective 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2007. Passengers will benefit from a more convenient and faster handling due to close proximity of departure gates and less waiting time at security points.

Terminal 2 will provide Air Mauritius' passengers with numerous advantages: Check-in area located in Hall D, is closer to the departure concourse. Check-in desks can be found easily especially for all passengers arriving by Sky Train from Terminal 1. Customers using the special Air Mauritius' service "*Easy Park & Fly*", which provides free parking facilities, will also enjoy the convenience of a car park located just opposite the terminal. First and Business class passengers may now stay longer in the lounge as it is located right in the departure area.

*"Finally our passengers will benefit from a smoother handling as Terminal 2 is a modern and less congested Terminal. This will further enhance our services on the ground",* says Pramod Gujadhur, Area Manager of Air Mauritius for Germany.
